Residency must be proven in order to receive any scholarship from the state of Florida including Florida Bright Futures, Florida Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grant, Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG), and Children and Spouses of Deceased and Disabled (CS/DV).

Florida Residency Conditions:

A Florida resident for tuition and financial aid purposes is a person (or a dependent person whose parent or guardian) established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve months prior to the start of the academic term. Residence in Florida must be a bona fide domicile, other than for educational purposes. Persons not meeting the twelve-month legal residence requirement may be classified a Florida resident if they fall within one of the limited special categories authorized by the Florida legislature and Board of Regents. All other persons are ineligible for classification as a Florida resident for tuition purposes.

Student Citizenship Certification:

To qualify for Florida resident financial aid programs the student must be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen. Please check one of the following. If neither apply, you are not eligible for Florida resident financial aid.

- I am a U.S. citizen
- I am an eligible non-citizen (please attach a copy of the front and back of your resident alien card or appropriate visa)  
Generally, you are considered an eligible non-citizen if you are one of the following:
  - U.S. permanent resident or conditional permanent resident with a Permanent Resident Card (formerly known as an Alien Registration Receipt Card or "Green Card")
  - Other eligible non-citizen with an Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from the Department of Homeland Security showing any one of the following designations: "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Indefinite Parole," "Humanitarian Parole," or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant" or with one of the following visas:
    - A, E, G, H-1B-1C, I, KL, N, M-1, O-1, R, S, T, U, Y, CE
  - A citizen of the Republic of Palau (PW), the Republic of the Marshall Islands (MH), or the Federated States of Micronesia (FM).
